

## NOTICE OF ELECTION

### TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF FORT BEND COUNTY FRESH WATER SUPPLY DISTRICT NO. 1, AND TO ALL OTHER INTERESTED PERSONS:

Notice is hereby given that an election will be conducted by Fort Bend County for Fort Bend County Fresh Water Supply District No. 1 (the "District") at the polling places listed in Attachment A – Election Day Vote Centers, attached hereto, in accordance with an order (the "Order") adopted by the Board of Supervisors of the District on February 16, 2017.

The District has entered into a Joint Election Agreement and Contract for Election Services (the "Contract") with Fort Bend County (the "County") which provides that the County will conduct the election on behalf of the District.

A copy of the Order and Contract are available in the office of the District at 1980 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 1380, Houston, Texas 77056.

Subject to the provisions of Chapter 31, Subchapter D of the Election Code, the District agrees to allow the County to administer an election to be held for the District on May 6, 2017 between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., at the places determined by the County and listed in Attachment A – Election Day Vote Centers, attached hereto. Pursuant to the Contract, the District has directed that the places for the election be suitable public buildings and proper places for conducting said election.

The following proposition shall be submitted to the resident electors of the District at the May 6, 2017 election:

#### PROPOSITION I

SHALL THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF FORT BEND COUNTY FRESH WATER SUPPLY DISTRICT NO. 1 BE AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE THE BONDS OF SAID DISTRICT IN ONE OR MORE ISSUES OR SERIES IN THE MAXIMUM PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF \$79,000,000 MATURING SERIALLY OR OTHERWISE IN SUCH INSTALLMENTS AS ARE FIXED BY SAID BOARD OVER A PERIOD OR PERIODS NOT EXCEEDING FORTY (40) YEARS FROM THEIR DATE OR DATES, BEARING INTEREST AT ANY RATE OR RATES, AND TO SELL SAID BONDS AT ANY PRICE OR PRICES, PROVIDED THAT THE NET EFFECTIVE INTEREST RATE, AS DEFINED BY CHAPTER 1204, TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE, AS AMENDED, ON ANY ISSUE OR SERIES OF SAID BONDS SHALL NOT EXCEED THE MAXIMUM LEGAL LIMIT IN EFFECT AT THE TIME OF ISSUANCE OF EACH SUCH ISSUE OR SERIES, ALL AS MAY BE DETERMINED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF SAID DISTRICT, FOR THE PURPOSE OR PURPOSES OF REPAIRING, REHABILITATING, AND MAKING CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS TO THE DISTRICT'S EXISTING WATERWORKS SYSTEM AND SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM TO SERVE LAND LOCATED WITHIN THE DISTRICT AND PURCHASING OR OTHERWISE ACQUIRING ANY AND ALL PROPERTY, CONTRACT RIGHTS, RIGHTS OF USE AND INTEREST IN PROPERTY NECESSARY, APPROPRIATE OR INCIDENT TO THE REPAIR, REHABILITATION, AND MAKING OF CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS TO THE DISTRICT'S EXISTING WATERWORKS SYSTEM AND SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM, ALL AS MORE FULLY DESCRIBED IN THAT CERTAIN ENGINEER'S REPORT APPROVED BY THE DISTRICT ON FEBRUARY 16, 2017, AND FOR THE ADDITIONAL PURPOSE OF PAYING ALL EXPENSES IN ANY MANNER INCIDENTAL THERETO AND SUCH EXPENSES AS ARE INCIDENTAL TO THE ADMINISTRATION, AND FINANCING OF THE DISTRICT WHICH UNDER APPLICABLE LAW MAY PROPERLY BE PAID FROM THE PROCEEDS OF SUCH BONDS AND IN AN AMOUNT NOT IN EXCESS OF \$115,000,000 FOR THE PURPOSE OF REFUNDING ANY BONDS OR OTHER EVIDENCES OF INDEBTEDNESS ISSUED BY THE DISTRICT FOR ANY OF THE FOREGOING PURPOSES, AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT OF PRINCIPAL OF AND INTEREST ON SUCH BONDS BY THE LEVY AND COLLECTION OF A SUFFICIENT TAX UPON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN SAID DISTRICT, ALL AS AUTHORIZED BY THE CONSTITUTION AND LAWS OF THE STATE OF TEXAS, INCLUDING PARTICULARLY (BUT NOT BY WAY OF LIMITATION) CHAPTERS 49 AND 53 OF THE TEXAS WATER CODE, TO THE EXTENT APPLICABLE, TOGETHER WITH ALL AMENDMENTS AND ADDITIONS THERETO; SAID BONDS IF AUTHORIZED, TO BE ISSUED IN ADDITION TO THE REMAINING AUTHORIZED BUT UNISSUED BONDS APPROVED PURSUANT TO THE ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 2, 2004 WITH SUCH BONDS VALIDATED AND REAUTHORIZED TO BE ISSUED?

Voting in said election shall be by the use of an electronic voting system prepared by the County pursuant to the Contract and Texas Election Code, Chapter 123. Ballots shall be printed in both English and Spanish as required by federal voting rights law. The ballots used in the election shall have printed thereon the following:

AGAINST

The Elections Administrator of Fort Bend County (the "Administrator") shall appoint the presiding judges and clerks for the election pursuant to the Contract. The Administrator may appoint, as he or she deems necessary, clerks to assist in the conduct of the election.

The early voting ballot board shall be appointed by the Administrator in accordance with the Contract.

Early voting in the election by personal appearance shall occur as provided by the County pursuant to the Contract. The clerk for early voting shall be the Administrator, and the places at which such early voting shall be conducted are to be determined by the County pursuant to the Contract. The places and times at which early voting by personal appearance shall be conducted are set forth in Exhibit "B" hereto. The early voting clerk's mailing address to which ballot applications and ballots to be voted by mail may be sent is Mr. John Oldham, Elections Administrator of Fort Bend County, 301 Jackson Street, Richmond, Texas 77469. The early voting clerk's email address to which applications for ballots to be voted by mail may be sent is [vote@fortbendcountytexas.gov](mailto:vote@fortbendcountytexas.gov).

The Administrator is hereby appointed as the agent for the Secretary of the Board of the District for the purpose of being custodian of the election records. The agent shall maintain election records in accordance with the Texas Election Code.

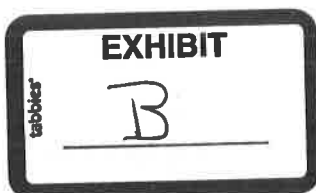
All qualified resident electors of the District shall be entitled to vote in the election.
